Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is issuing an administrative amendment to the Major Facility Review Permit for Air Liquide Large Industries (Facility Number B7419).

The purpose of this administrative amendment is to correct typographical errors in the initial compliance certification period and the deadline for the initial compliance certification. Pursuant to District Regulation 2-6-201, typographical errors are non-substantive administrative amendments to major facility review permits. The District's practice is to set the end of the initial compliance certification period about one year after issuance of the initial Title V permit. In this case, it was erroneously set at about 4 months after issuance. The beginning of Paragraph I.G will now read:

"Compliance certifications shall be submitted annually by the responsible official of this facility to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District and to the Environmental Protection Agency. The initial certification period will be ~~July 1<sup>st</sup> March 4<sup>th</sup>~~ through ~~June February 28<sup>th</sup>30<sup>th</sup>~~. Subsequent certification periods will be March 1<sup>st</sup> through February 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup>. The certifications shall be submitted by ~~July 30<sup>th</sup> March 31<sup>st</sup>~~ of each year."

The District will also notify the California Air Resources Board that the permit has been amended.
