This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is issuing an administrative amendment to the Major Facility Review Permit for Air Liquide Large Industries (Facility Number B7419).

The purpose of this administrative amendment is to amend the non-federally enforceable ammonia monitoring conditions. Amendment of non-federally enforceable provisions are defined as administrative amendments in BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-201.
