

NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites interested persons to submit written public comments on the proposed initial Major Facility Review Permit for the following facility:

Major facilities are required to obtain an operating permit under Title V of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, the Federal Operating Permit Program and the District's Regulation 2, Rule 6 - Major Facility Review. The permits summarize all air-related requirements that apply to each source of emissions at each facility.

The Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the proposed initial Title V permit for the facility listed above. Comments must be received by October 14, 2015. Any interested person may also request a public hearing for this permit.

Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed permit and the District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region 9, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of the 45-day US EPA review period, to reconsider the decision to not object to the permit.
