Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District will conduct the first of two required public hearings on **May 21, 2014**, at the District's Headquarters Board Room, 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, California, at 9:45 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to review the District's **Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-2015**, and to allow the public an opportunity to comment upon the Proposed Budget.

Copies of the Proposed Budget and supporting documents, including a schedule of fees to be imposed by the District to fund its programs, are available for public inspection during regular business hours, at the offices of the Finance Department, Fourth Floor, Bay Area Air Quality Management District, 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, California. Any member of the public may appear at the hearing and be heard regarding the increase, decrease or omission of any item of the Proposed Budget or for the inclusion of additional items.

The Board will not take final action to adopt the District's Budget at the May 21, 2014 hearing. The District's Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Budget will come before the Board of Directors for final adoption at the second public hearing to be held on **June 4, 2014**. This hearing will also be conducted at the District's Headquarters Board Room, 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, California, at 9:45 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

The Board of Directors will also conduct the second, and final, public hearing on proposed amendments to the District's fee regulation on June 4, 2014. If adopted, the proposed amendments would become effective on July 1, 2014.
