## What is the purpose of the workshop?

- The 2009 CAP will present a plan to reduce ozone, particulate matter, air toxics, and greenhouse gases. At this workshop District staff will describe the draft multi-pollutant evaluation methodology (MPEM) that will be used to help evaluate control measures for the 2009 CAP based on their potential to protect public health and our climate.
- Receive public input on the MPEM or other aspects of the CAP.
- Describe future steps and milestones in developing the CAP.
