# Bay Area 2009 Clean Air Plan Public Workshop & CEQA Scoping Meeting

**September 2 and September 3, 2009 — New dates for public workshops on the Bay Area 2009 Clean Air Plan (CAP) draft control strategy and CEQA scoping meetings on the draft environmental impact report for the CAP.**

The purpose of these workshops is to present the draft control strategy of the 2009 Clean Air Plan for public review and comment. The control strategy aims to reduce ozone precursors, while also addressing particulate matter, air toxics, and greenhouse gases. The control strategy will include measures to reduce emissions from both mobile and stationary sources.

At the CEQA scoping meetings District staff will seek input on the scope of the environmental analysis of the CAP. Comments focusing on your area of expertise, your agency's area of jurisdiction, or issues relative to the environmental analysis are encouraged. A Notice of Preparation (NOP) and an Initial Study for a Draft Program Environmental Impact Report for the CAP will be posted on the CAP website no later than August 21.
