Who is eligible?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only truck owners that receive a notification letter from ARB are eligible. Letters were sent the week of December 19, 2011.</li> <li>• The list of trucks (by VIN or plate number) that will receive a letter can be viewed at <a href="http://www.arb.ca.gov/gmbond/">http://www.arb.ca.gov/gmbond/</a>.</li> <li>• To receive a letter, your truck must have all of the following:           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ A model Year 1994-2003 engine</li> <li>○ An original manufacturer's GVWR 33,001+ lbs.</li> <li>○ A diesel particulate filter (Filter) installed by June 30, 2010 AND registered in California Drayage Truck Registry.</li> <li>○ 12+ port/rail yard visits during 2011</li> <li>○ Traveled at least 5,000 miles and 75% of miles in California in 2010 and 2011</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Funding Available	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to \$30,000 for a grant to be used to purchase a replacement truck and</li> <li>• ARB Loan Assistance</li> </ul>
What kind of truck do I need to get?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A truck with a 2007 or newer engine*</li> <li>• Manufacturer's GVWR 33,001+ lbs (Class 8)</li> <li>• Less than 500,000 miles</li> <li>• Must have a minimum 1-year or 100,000-mile major component engine warranty that covers parts and labor</li> <li>• Must get new truck by 12/31/2012</li> </ul>
Until I get my new truck, my old truck needs to be:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Kept registered</li> <li>• Kept in legal operating condition</li> <li>• Clear of outstanding vehicle or fleet ARB violations</li> </ul>
After I get my new truck, what do I need to do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sign a contract for 5 years (or 350,000 miles)</li> <li>• Travel at least 90% of the miles in California per year</li> <li>• Give up your old truck in <b>operational</b> condition with working filter to air district or dismantler</li> </ul>
Important Deadlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applications must be <b>post-marked by February 9, 2012</b> and must include registration and proof of financing**</li> <li>• Replacement truck must be <b>operational by December 31, 2012</b></li> </ul>
Is there going to be other funding?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is the last opportunity to get State funds to replace these trucks</li> </ul>

*\*Not all new truck engines are eligible. Engine must meet the 2007 emissions level of 1.20 g/bhp-hr or less NOx (FEL and CERT values) and 0.01 g/bhp-hr or less PM (CERT value). Engine certified under the heavy-heavy duty designation for on-road use. List of eligible engines can be found at the Program website <http://www.arb.ca.gov/gmbond>*

Proof of Financing Requirements	<p>Documents must be submitted with the application to show that you have the rest of the funds to purchase the new or used truck.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Acceptable proof of financing documents include any of the following or a combination of the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Bank statement for the truck owner showing cash availability; or a letter from a bank stating the truck owner has cash available</li><li>○ Financing commitment letter from an established lender to the truck owner</li><li>○ Bank statement showing the truck owner has available funds under a line of credit; or a letter from a bank stating the truck owner has funds available under a line of credit.</li></ul></li></ul>

Bank means any established financial institution that offers deposit accounts, loans, and other financial services.
