RULE 8

HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM AIRBORNE TOXIC CONTROL MEASURE FOR CHROME PLATING AND CHROMIC ACID ANODIZING OPERATIONS

(Adopted July 20, 1988)

The provisions of <u>Section 93102</u>, <u>Subchapter 7.5</u>, <u>Chapter 1</u>, <u>Division 3</u>, <u>Title 17</u>, of the California Code of Regulations: "Hexavalent Chromium Airborne Toxic Control Measure For Chrome Plating And Chromic Acid Anodizing Operations" are made part of the Rules and Regulations of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District. Whenever any source is subject to more than one rule, regulation, provision, or requirement relating to the control of any air contaminant, in cases of conflict or duplication, the most stringent rule, regulation, provision, or requirement shall apply.
