My name is Heidi Taylor and I am a founding member of Healthy Martinez: Refinery Accountability Group. I live on the PBF/MRC fence line in downtown Martinez. I applaud the district's effort to improve Rule 11-18. It is imperative, however, that the reporting not be delegated to the refineries. The scores must be based on independent, verifiable data obtained by EPA methods so that our communities can rely on this information. We depend on the Air District to prioritize our health and well being and that starts with accurate information about toxic emissions from local refineries. Please do not allow refineries to self-report. Do not take their green-washed information and pass it on to us with a BAAQMD seal of approval. Give us a health risk assessment that we can count on.
