

What is a vision?

- A collaborative process in which a community creates the future it wants by identifying their purpose, values, and shared aspirations for the future.

"Our vision is an atmosphere that enables people and the planet to thrive – a stabilized climate with warming limited to 1.5C and drastically reduced air pollution."

Value of Vision and Principles



- Brings community together to share the change they would like to see
- Reflects what matters most and strengthens trust within the community
