# Key Accomplishments

CSC subject-matter expertise and lived experience surfaced the priorities of East Oakland residents, leading to several actions related to urban greening, workforce development, and illegal dumping.

# Key Accomplishments

Extensive outreach led by trusted community partners

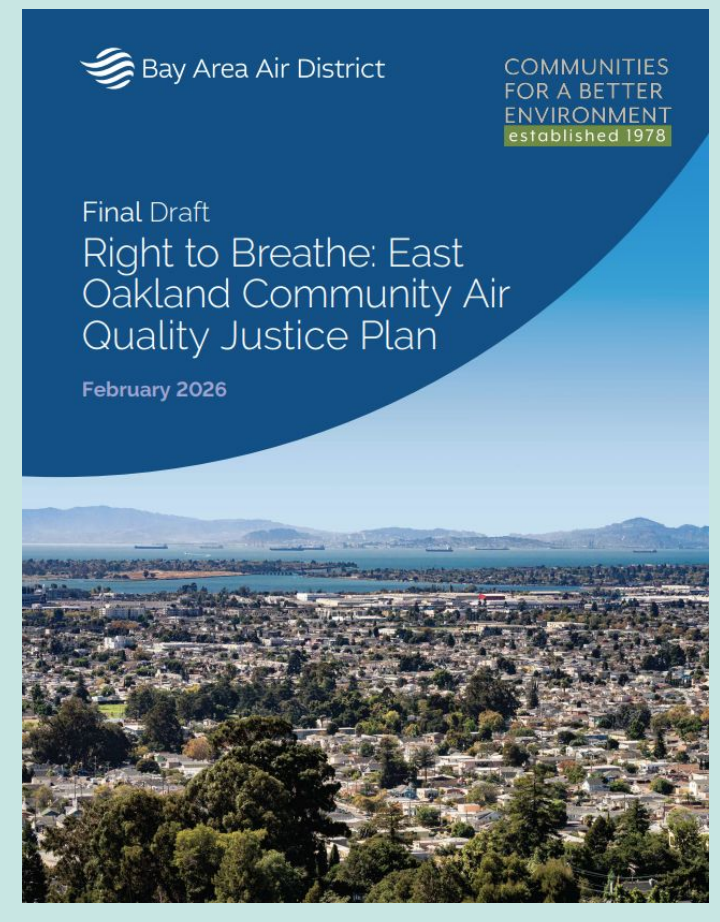


Four community-based organizations (CBOs) reached out to East Oakland residents and gathered nearly **480 comments and concerns** through the **Community Mapping Project**.



Four CBOs collected over **400 surveys** through the **Community Organizing Grants**. Feedback confirmed: proposed strategies address most pressing air quality issues in East Oakland.

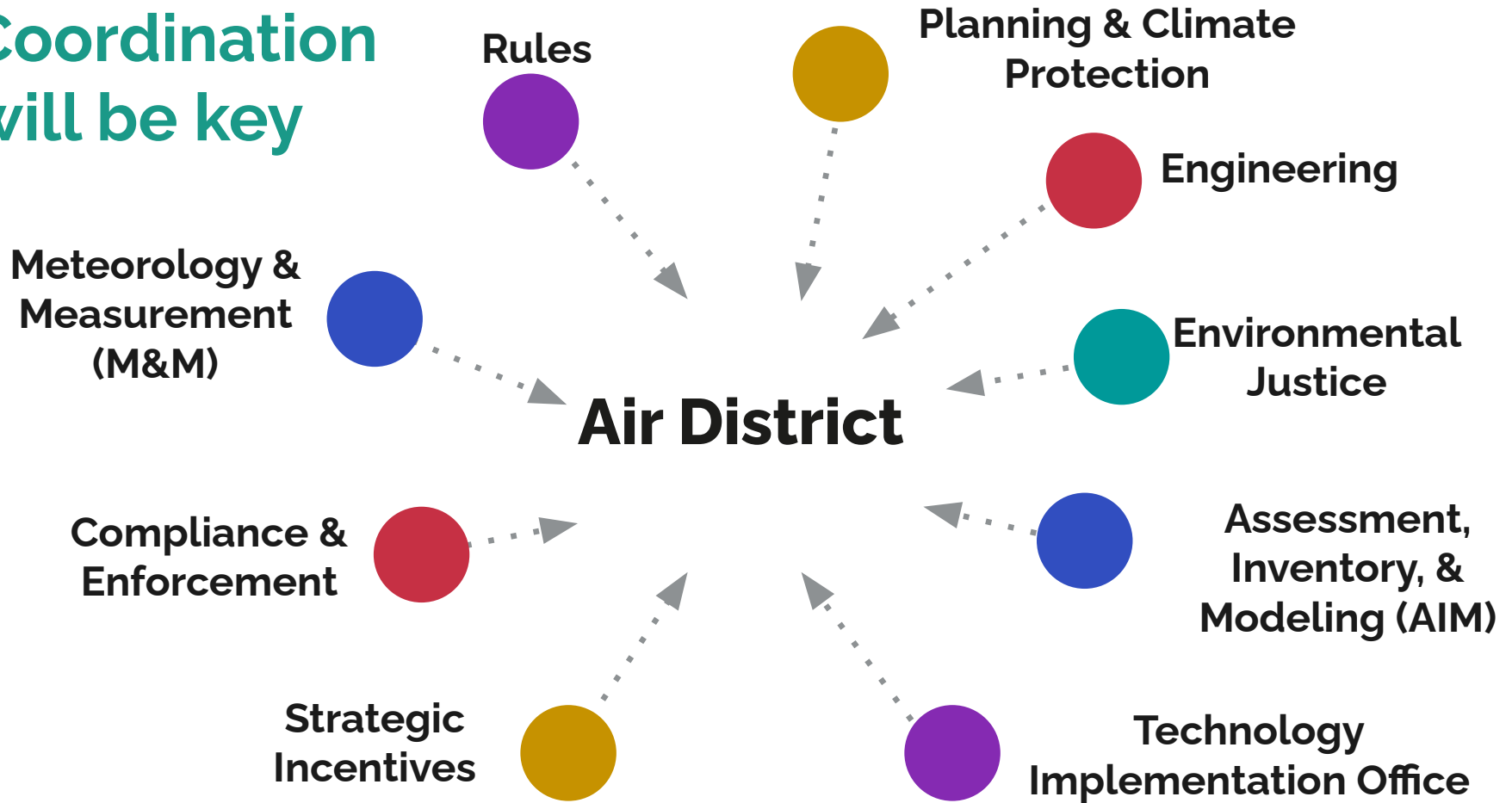

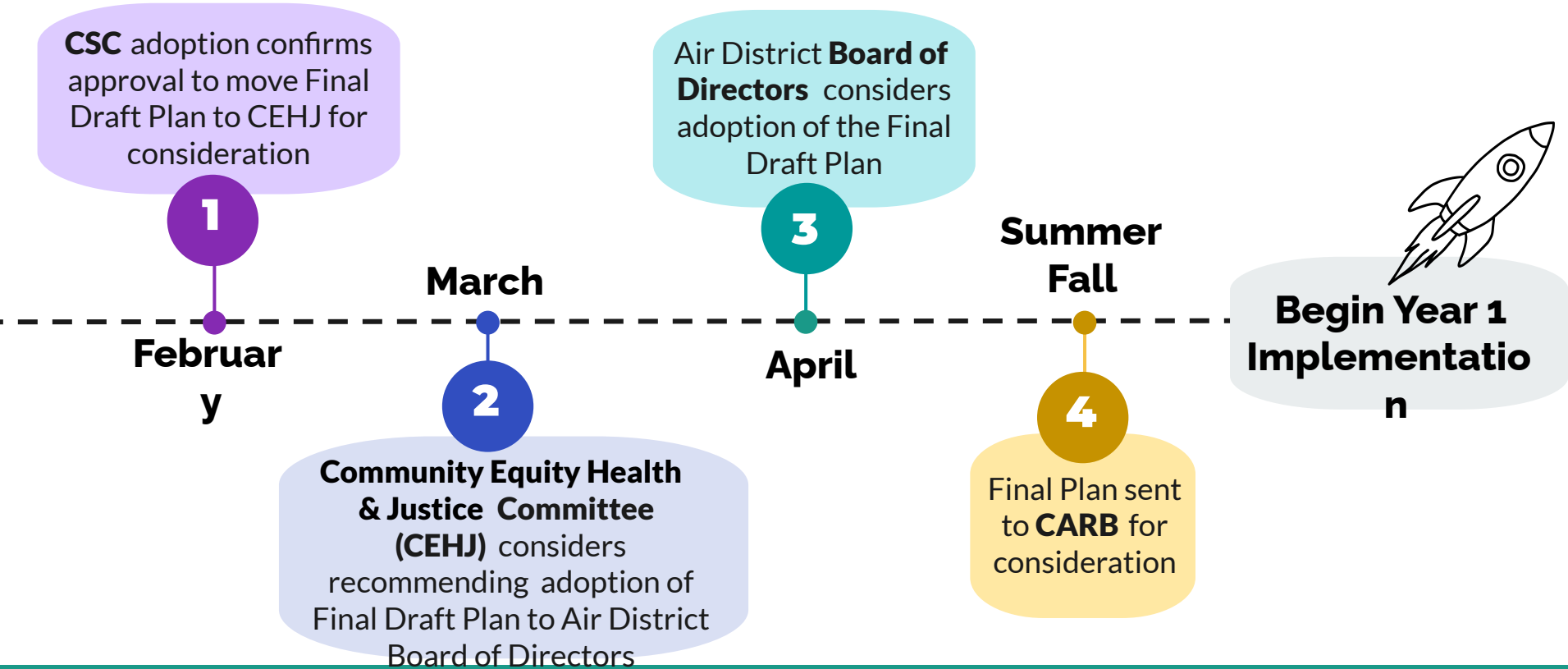

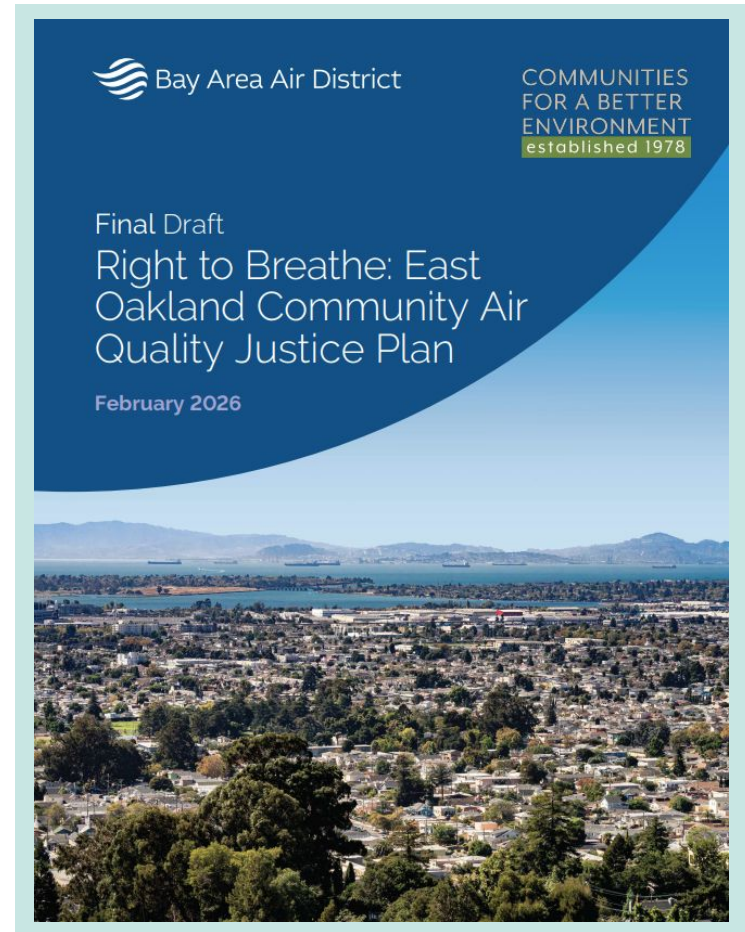
