





Extensive outreach led by trusted community partners




HIGHER GROUND

Four community-based organizations (CBOs) reached out to East Oakland residents and gathered nearly **480 comments and concerns** through the **Community Mapping Project**.

Four CBOs collected over **400 surveys** through the **Community Organizing Grants**. Feedback confirmed: proposed strategies address most pressing air quality issues in East Oakland.






