1. Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (From India or Canada)

Yes, companies outside the USA are eligible to respond.

2. Whether we need to come over there for meetings?

The selected Vendor will be expected to come to the District offices on an as-needed basis and to use online meeting services for additional support.

Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (From India or Canada)

Work can be done remotely but the selected Vendor will be expected to come to the District offices on an as-needed basis.

4. Can we submit our proposals via email?

The electronic copy can be emailed but two (2) hard copies are required and must be mailed.

5. Are companies outside USA eligible to respond to this RFP? Also, will preference be given to SF Bay area companies only or other companies from other US regions can apply?

Yes, companies outside the USA are eligible to respond.

Yes, location will be taken into consideration with preference for local companies.

6. Do you need Onsite Resources for work, or Offsite from our Texas Office or Offshore office in China be allowed?

Work can be done remotely but the selected Vendor will be expected to come to the District offices on an as-needed basis and to use online meeting services for support.

7. For the Cost Proposal section Response, is providing hourly rates of developers OK, as we will not be able to provide total number of hours estimated for each level of professional and administrative staff as noted in the RFP presently as the work details are not fully clear at present mentioned under "SECTION III – SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR WEB MAINTENANCE AND PROJECTS"?
