Dear Vehicle/Motorcycle Owner:

The registration on your motorcycle or model year 19(Vintage) vehicle is expiring soon. You can receive \$1,200 for your vehicle or \$500 for your motorcycle from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) and help reduce air pollution. The Air District is the government agency responsible for air quality in the San Francisco Bay Area.

The Vehicle Buy Back Program buys and scraps 1997 and older vehicles and all motorcycles. **This program is** completely voluntary. If your vehicle or motorcycle is considered classic or otherwise valuable to you, you may disregard this letter.

Below is a **partial list** of requirements your vehicle or motorcycle must meet to qualify. Vehicle or motorcycle must:

- ☑ Be currently registered as operable and be in operating condition
- ☐ Have been registered as operable in the Bay Area for the past 2 years
- ☐ Take and pass a Smog Check if within 60 days of a required Smog Check (motorcycles exempt)

What to do: Call an approved auto/motorcycle dismantler, who will determine if your vehicle/motorcycle qualifies.

If your vehicle or motorcycle meets all the program requirements, the dismantler will buy and scrap your vehicle/vehicle and provide you a check for \$1,200 for your vehicle or \$500 for your motorcycle. Visit www.baaqmd.gov/vbb for more details.
