

## Phase 2 Next Steps (cont.)

**\$315,000**

- Up to \$315,000
- Includes architectural design and planning work
- Structural engineering to design seismic upgrade
- Structural engineering to include specifications to accommodate rooftop solar
- Includes contingency cost

# Phase 2 Next Steps (cont.)




## Seismic Upgrade

**\$1,500,000**

- Up to \$1,500,000
- Includes general contractor
- All of Lakeside Drive building, including Phase 1
- Bidding process
- Contracts: future approval

# Budget Considerations/ Financial Impact




Funding for the architectural planning and design of the Richmond, Lakeside building is included in the proposed budget for Fiscal Year Ending 2020.

Funding for the seismic upgrade work, if approved at a future meeting, will be allocated from the Air District reserve fund.

# Recommended Action



The Committee will consider recommending the Board of Directors authorize the Executive Officer/APCO to execute contracts with Brereton Architecture + Interiors and Cushman & Wakefield to plan and design approximately 31,000 square feet of the Richmond, Lakeside building, in an amount not to exceed \$315,000, and to obtain bids to seismically upgrade the Richmond, Lakeside building. Staff will return to the Committee to discuss authorization to execute contracts for the seismic work.
