Background Bay Area Clean Air Foundation (BACAF)

- July September 2008 BACAF was created:
 - Provide financial, administrative, programmatic, and other forms of support to the Air District; and
 - Engage in activities that further such purpose
- BACAF Directors
 - Damian Breen
 - Kraig Kurucz
 - Brian Bunger

Reformulated Gas Settlement Fund (RFG)

- RFG Open Grants Program competitive grants to non-profits from antitrust class action lawsuit
- Air District Board of Directors authorized acceptance of up to \$2 million from BACAF in 11/2017
- BACAF and RFG executed contract for \$1.3 million in 12/2017





Reformulated Gas Settlement Fund (cont.) Status as of 4/4/2020



Nine (9) projects in CARE Areas awarded \$1,014,130

\$557,980 TFCA funds awarded as match
