BACKGROUND



- The Hearing Board is a quasi-judicial body that rules on particular cases that typically affect only individual facilities. It is authorized to hear requests for variance relief, permit revocation, abatement orders, and appeals by permit applicants, or by interested third parties, concerning the issuance or denial of permits.
- The Hearing Board consists of five members and their alternates, including the following categories: Professional Engineer, Attorney, Medical Profession, and two Public Members.
- Hearing Board members serve a term of three years and are eligible for reappointment until they have served 15 consecutive years.

RECRUITMENT



- There are six vacancies: one (Alternate) in the Professional Engineer category, two (Principal) in the Public Category, two (Alternate) in the Public Category, and one (Alternate) in the Medical Category.
- The recruitment for these positions were posted on March 25, 2020 and applications were due April 10, 2020.
- The positions were promoted in nine newspapers throughout the Bay Area, as well as websites, mailing lists, etc.

- Seventeen (17) applications were received, 16 for the (Principal or Alternate) Public Category and one (1) for the (Alternate) Medical Category.
- Twelve (12) candidates were invited to interview, 11 for the (Principal or Alternate) Public Category and one (1) for the (Alternate) Medical Category.
