

This summer, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) is hosting “OS101”, a Hearing Board training, at various air district offices throughout California.

CARB will offer this training at the **Bay Area Air Quality Management District** office on:

This training will be in-person only (no virtual option offered).

Continental breakfast provided; a lunch break will occur during the middle of the training, and participants are on their own!

Training description:

CARB staff will discuss the Health and Safety Code requirements pertaining to air district hearing board actions and proceedings for granting variances from district requirements, hearing permit disputes, and issuing abatement orders, and describe the role of each entity involved in a hearing board proceeding. CARB is providing this training as part of its work coordinating with and supporting the work of local air districts. This training concerns issues of general interest to the public, air districts, and district hearing boards. The training is open to the public. No specific matters within the subject matter jurisdiction of any hearing board or of CARB will be heard, discussed, or deliberated, and thus does not constitute a meeting of CARB, any air district, or any hearing board, and no public comment will be taken. (Public notice of the training is being given in the interests of public participation, if a majority of the members of any district hearing board attends.)

Prerequisite Course Required:

Prior to attending the in-person training, please complete prerequisite course *OS100 - Variance/Hearing Board Training*. The in-person training will review and expand on material presented in OS100.

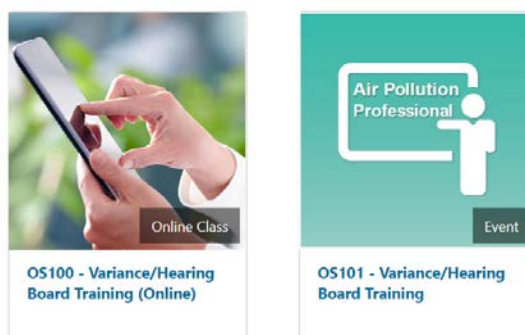
How to Register:
