## Public Input Sought on Reducing Refinery Emissions Air District Holding Community Meetings

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) will hold a series of community meetings in northern Contra Costa County and in Benicia to update residents on proposals being developed to reduce emissions at Bay Area refineries. The meetings will focus on a number of proposals including refinery flares, depressurization of process vessels, equipment leaks, marine loading operations and waste water systems.

Workgroups that include environmentalists, industry personnel and staff from the California Air Resources Board have been working with the Air District on the draft proposals. The purpose of the community meetings is to give a status report on the proposals, outline the process of bringing draft rules before the Air District's Board of Directors for possible adoption, and provide a forum for comments and discussion. The draft proposals are available on the Air District's web site at <a href="https://www.baaqmd.gov">www.baaqmd.gov</a> under Rules & Regulations, Workshops.

"The Air District has existing rules to reduce emissions from refineries," said William C. Norton, the Air District's Executive Officer. "We are now working with the community to look at additional controls that would incorporate advances in technology, and require industries to adhere to more stringent standards," Norton added.
