### **Air District Board to vote on bold climate plan** ***Spare the Air, Cool the Climate***

**SAN FRANCISCO** – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District Board of Directors will vote to adopt a visionary climate plan that challenges federal efforts to dismantle air quality improvement and climate protection programs. The plan, titled *Spare the Air-Cool the Climate*, is a blueprint for reducing regional air pollution and climate change pollutants with efforts to improve the health of Bay Area residents for the next several decades. The action will take place at the Air District Board of Director’s meeting on Wednesday, April 19, 2017.
