Air District statement on former employees' allegations

SAN FRANCISCO – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District has issued the following statement following a press release from former employees regarding missing records.

These allegations about missing records by Mr. Bachmann, a former employee, and Ms. Steele, a former temporary employee, are false. The allegations were first raised over a year ago and were thoroughly investigated by an outside law firm. The allegations were determined to be false and without merit. The Air District complies with all document retention requirements in state and federal law.

Because these allegations involve pending litigation, the Air District will not comment further at this time.

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (www.baaqmd.gov) is the regional agency responsible for protecting air quality in the nine-county Bay Area.
