### **Air District Board postpones historic vote on greenhouse gas cap for region's five refineries**

**SAN FRANCISCO** – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District Board of Directors today postponed a vote on a first-in-the-nation greenhouse gas cap on the five regional refineries. At issue was concern over what the refinery emission limits are currently and where the cap would be set to allow for a legally defensible limit moving forward. The Air District Board of Directors voted to bring the rule back for consideration in the future.
