SAN FRANCISCO – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District and the steering committee for the Richmond – San Pablo Community Air Monitoring Plan will host the Path to Clean Air Community Summit on Saturday, November 2, from 10:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. at the Richmond Memorial Auditorium located at 403 Civic Center Plaza in Richmond.
