Air District to deliver air filtration units for Pier 94 transitional housing site residents

SAN FRANCISCO – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District will deliver air filtration units to Pier 94 transitional housing site residents in Bayview on Wednesday, June 23. The site, with more than 120 RV trailers, was established by the City of San Francisco last year to shelter unhoused residents during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Air District will be holding a press conference to provide an overview of air quality concerns and actions that are being taken to protect the health of the Pier 94 transitional housing site residents.

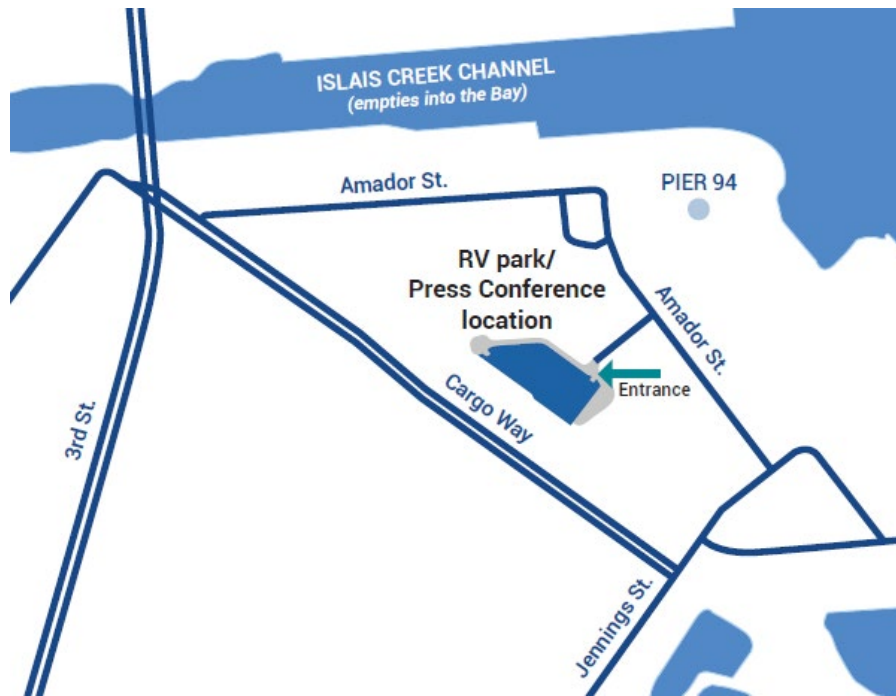
WHERE: Pier 94 transitional housing site for unhoused Bayview Hunters Point residents, San Francisco
