- Women in the U.S. still earn only 82 cents for every dollar earned by men. The gaps are even wider for Black women (69¢), Native women (57¢), and Latinas (54¢).
- Women make up nearly half of the workforce, yet hold only 10 percent of Fortune 500
 CEO roles.
- In the U.S., only 1 in 4 Congress members are women despite women being 51
 percent of the population.
- Women of color are disproportionately impacted by environmental injustice, maternal health disparities and lack of access to clean air and healthcare.
