

# PUBLIC NOTICE

TO: All residential and business neighbors located within 1,000 feet of the proposed new or modified source(s) of air pollution listed below.

FROM: Bay Area Air District

RE: Permit Application #727025 for the following source(s) of air pollution:

**(2) Portable Prime Direct-Drive Diesel Fire Pump Engines**

**Mare Island Dry Dock, LLC**

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (the “Bay Area Air District” or “Air District”) is a local agency that regulates stationary sources of air pollution such as factories, industrial sites, and gasoline stations.

Whenever we receive a permit application for a new or modified source(s) of toxic air contaminants located within 1,000 feet of a school site or within a community that is overburdened by air pollution, we notify the public about the proposed project. To comply with Bay Area Air District requirements, we distribute or mail a Public Notice to the parents or guardians of students enrolled at schools located within ¼ mile, and all residents and businesses located within 1,000 feet, of the proposed source(s).

You are receiving this Public Notice because a permit application has been filed with the Air District for the above referenced source(s) of air pollution. A description of the proposed project follows:

*Mare Island Dry Dock, LLC* has applied for authorization to construct two (2) new portable prime direct-drive diesel fire pump engines. The generators will operate only when onboard vessel fire suppression systems are temporarily disabled for maintenance. In both cases, the portable diesel engine provides standby fire protection and is not intended for operational or continuous service.

***PRELIMINARY EVALUATION***

The Air District has evaluated the permit application for the proposed project and has made a preliminary determination that the project is expected to comply with all applicable District, state, and federal air quality-related regulations, including the health risks resulting from toxic air contaminant emissions. The preliminary recommendation is to issue a permit for this project. After considering all comments received, the Air District will make a final determination.
