



Examples of Equipment and Facilities Commonly Requiring Permits from the Air District

The table below gives examples of equipment and facilities that commonly require permitting by the Air District. The list is not comprehensive and is meant to give a general idea of some regulations that are typically considered in the evaluation of a permit application. Other local, state, and federal regulations may apply. Boilers	Reg 9-7: Nitrogen Oxides And Carbon Monoxide from Industrial, Institutional, and Commercial Boilers, Steam Generators, And Process Heaters
Emergency Generator	Reg 9-8: Nitrogen Oxides And Carbon Monoxide from Stationary Internal Combustion Engines
Gas Turbines	Reg 9-9: Nitrogen Oxides And Carbon Monoxide from Stationary Gas Turbines
