Mr. Sadeghipour,

This letter is to inform the District that Plant # A0621 – City of Santa Clara Cogen has been shut down permanently and will have no further operations.

Following the closure of California Paperboard who was the long-standing steam customer of the City, the one remaining Unit at Cogen (S-1) was shut down and ceased operation on November 11, 2023. There have been no operations since this date. Both combustion turbines (S-1, S-2) have been removed and the supplemental duct burners (S-3, S-4) have been disconnected for many years.

The City is aware that our Permit to Operate, expiring May 1, 2024 will not be renewed.
