The Board will not take final action to adopt the District's Budget at the May 5, 2021 hearing. The District's **Fiscal Year 2021-2022** Budget will come before the Board of Directors for final adoption at the second public hearing to be held on **June 16, 2021** at 9:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. This hearing may also be conducted under the procedures authorized by Executive Order N-29-20 issued by Governor Gavin Newsom and the public may observe this meeting through webcast.
