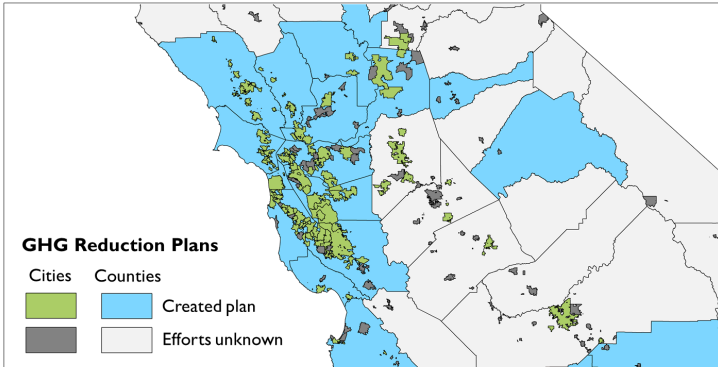

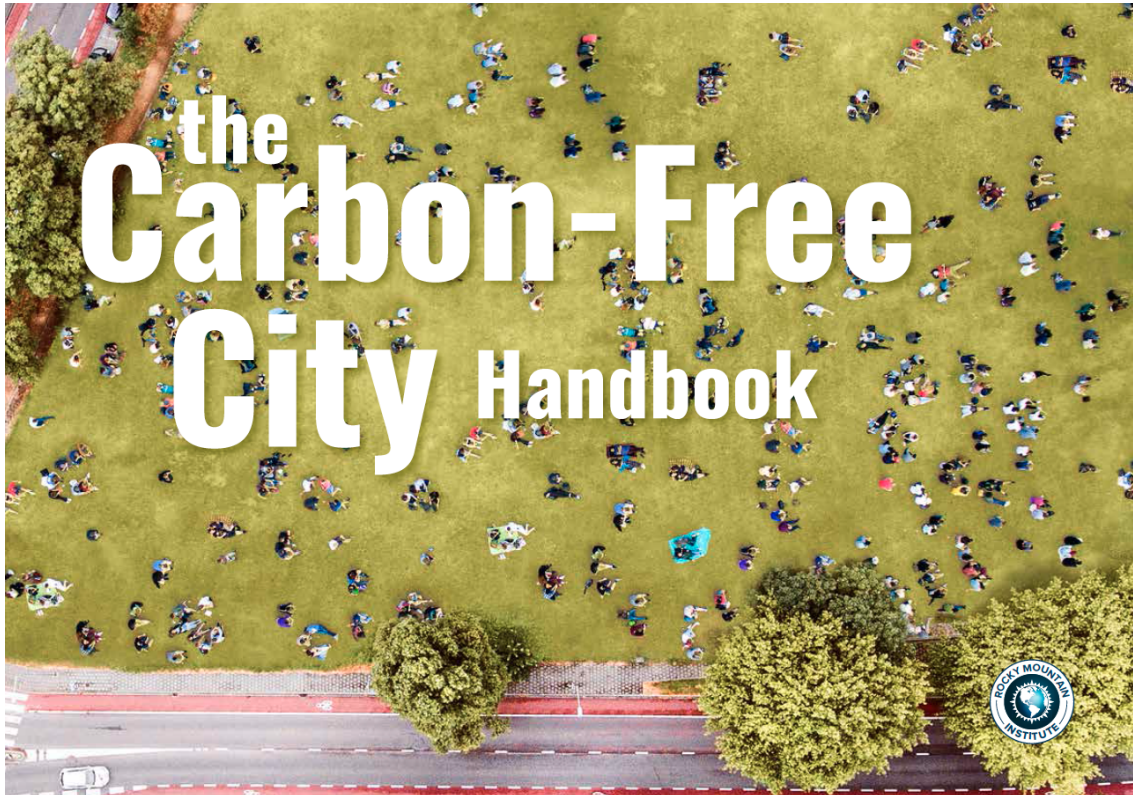
Solar PV Ordinance Toolkit
