SUBJECT: **PUBLIC WORKSHOP – DRAFT
AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION 3: FEES**

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (District) will conduct a public workshop on **Monday, March 14, 2011, starting at 1:30 PM**, to discuss draft amendments to District Regulation 3: Fees. The workshop will be held in the 7th floor Board of Directors meeting room at the District's office located at **939 Ellis Street in San Francisco**.

The amendments to the District's fee regulation would be effective on July 1, 2011, and would increase fee revenue in order to help the District recover a greater share of the costs the District incurs in implementing and enforcing regulatory programs for stationary sources of air pollution within the District's jurisdiction. The following changes to the District's Fee Schedules are proposed based on a recently updated analysis of cost recovery for its regulatory programs:

Schedule M	Major Stationary Source Fees	No change
Schedule N	Toxic Inventory Fees	10% increase

Schedule Q	Excavation of Contaminated Soil and Removal of Underground Storage Tanks	2% increase
Schedule R	Equipment Registration Fees	2% increase
Schedule S	Naturally Occurring Asbestos Operations	14% increase
Schedule T	Greenhouse Gas Fees	No change
Schedule U	Indirect Source Review Fees	No change

In addition, the following specific fees listed in Regulation 3 would be increased by 10 percent:

- Section 3-302: New and modified source filing fee.
- Section 3-311: Banking filing fee and withdrawal fee.
- Section 3-312: Regulation 2, Rule 9 Alternative Compliance Plan fee.
- Section 3-327: Permit to Operate renewal processing fee.
