# Refinery Emissions Tracking Rule Public Workshops

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites you to the following public workshops to discuss a new rule that is being developed that would apply to petroleum refineries. Background information will be shared at these meetings and the public is invited to give input.

The preliminary draft rule includes:

- tracking future air emissions from each refinery
- emissions increases above specified trigger-levels would require an explanation of the causes and plan for reduction
- fence-line and community-level air monitoring requirements
