The Bay Area Air Quality Management District will conduct a public workshop on **Tuesday**, **February 17**, **2015**, **starting at 10:00 AM**, to discuss draft amendments to District Regulation 3: Fees. The workshop will be held in the 7<sup>th</sup> floor Board of Directors meeting room at the District's office located at 939 Ellis Street in San Francisco and will be simultaneously webcast.

The amendments to the District's FYE 2016 fee regulation would be effective on July 1, 2015, and would increase fee revenue in order to help the District recover a greater share of the costs the District incurs in implementing and enforcing regulatory programs for stationary sources of air pollution. The following changes to the District's existing Fee Schedules are proposed based on a recently updated analysis of cost recovery for regulatory programs:

The following specific fees in Regulation 3 are proposed to be increased by 2.6 percent:

- Section 3-302: New and modified source filing fee
- Section 3-311: Banking filing fee and withdrawal fee
- Section 3-312: Regulation 2, Rule 9 Alternative Compliance Plan fee
- Section 3-327: Permit to Operate renewal processing fee

The following additional amendments are proposed:

- The facility registration fee in Section 4a of Schedule R: Equipment Registration Fees would be deleted and Section 4b amended to require a registration fee per device equal to \$100.
- The fee to alter a permitted source in Section 3-304 would be amended to be the same as the fee to modify a source found in Section 3-302.

Finally, Schedule T: Greenhouse Gas Fees will increase from \$0.07 to \$0.09 per metric ton of carbon dioxide equivalent (CDE) emissions. This fee rate was adopted in FYE 2015 as part of a two-year, phased increase per Board of Directors Resolution No. 2014-04.
