RULE 7
ROOFING ASPHALT**

[Effective 1 year after adoption]

6-7-100 GENERAL

6-7-101 Description: -The purpose of this Rule is to limit particulate emissions from roofing asphalt operations to reduce the amount of particulate matter in the atmosphere.

6-7-200 DEFINITIONS

6-7-201 Applicability of Common Definitions: The definitions in Regulation 1 (General Provisions and Definitions) and Regulation 6 (General Provisions, Definitions and Test Methods) shall apply to this rule.

6-7-202 Roofing Asphalt: The dark brown to black cementitious material (solid or liquid), of which the main constituents are bitumens, used as the primary layer of protection and sealant in Built Up roofing.

6-7-203 Low-Fuming Roofing Asphalt: Roofing asphalt specifically identified by the manufacturer Material Safety Data Sheet and packaging as low-fuming asphalt.

6-7-300 STANDARDS

6-7-301 Roofing Asphalt Operations: Except for hot rubber coatings used for waterproofing, no person may apply roofing asphalt unless it is low-fuming roofing asphalt.

6-7-400 ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS

6-7-500 MONITORING AND RECORDS

6-7-501 Recordkeeping: The owner/operator of a roofing asphalt operations shall keep records of purchases and use of low-fuming roofing asphalt and any non-compliant roofing asphalt to verify that only low-fuming product is used in the District. The owner/operator shall maintain all records required for two years, and shall make them available to the APCO upon request.
