SIGN UP FOR UPDATES ON THE WOOD SMOKE INCENTIVE REDUCTION PROGRAM



The Air District will be launching a Wood Smoke Reduction Incentive Program at 10 a.m. on August 26, 2016 to help reduce wintertime air pollution from wood burning. The program will provide funding to help approved Bay Area homeowners and landlords replace their wood-burning device with a qualifying electric, natural gas, or propane fueled device, or to decommission their fireplace.

WOOD SMOKE RULE CHANGES:

Starting November 1, 2016, anyone whose sole source of heat is a wood-burning device must use an EPA-certified or pellet-fueled device that must be registered with the Air District to qualify for an exemption. For details:
