

Acceptable Proof of Residency Documents

If Participant's residency address is different from the address listed on Participant's valid California driver's license, Participant must provide to the Air District one document listed below. All residency documents must list the Participant's first and last name and address (must be a residential address). Documents, such as bills, statements, and letters, must be dated within 90 days of application submittal or the date the application is reviewed.

- 1. Home utility bills (water, electricity/gas, trash/recycling, landline phone, cellular phone, internet/cable, or tv);
- 2. Medical documents;
- 3. Car registration or title;
- 4. Insurance documents (medical, dental, vision, life, home, rental, or vehicle);
- 5. Bank or financial institution records;
- 6. Change of address confirmation by the U.S. Postal Service or California Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV);
- 7. Mortgage bill;
- 8. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) or California Franchise Tax Board (FTB) tax return;
- Any document issued by an entity, office, or authority governing over a country, state, county, city, municipality, district, agency, department, or any other political subdivision of a country or state that is typed and contains the agency name, department name, state seal, or is on official letterhead;
- 10. Voter registration confirmation letter or postcard issued by the California Secretary of State or a local California county elections officer;
- 11. Deed or title to residential real property, property tax bill or statement;
- 12. A letter on letterhead from a homeless shelter, a shelter for abused women, a nonprofit entity, a faith-based organization, an employer, or government within the United States attesting that the applicant resides in an eligible CCFA zip code or disadvantaged community census tract; or
- 13. Employment documentation.

The Air District may accept other forms of proof of residency at its discretion.

If residency document(s) reflects a name that differs from the identity document due to a name change (e.g., marriage, divorce, or court order), additional documentation will be required as evidence of the name change. For example, a divorced individual may use the residency document(s) showing their prior last name by presenting a marriage certificate and/or dissolution of marriage document showing the name change.

Please note that if Participant purchases or leases a replacement vehicle, the address listed on the sales contract or lease contract must match Participant's residential address.
