Upcoming Program Changes
January 19, 2024

This Advisory is provided to inform you that the Bay Area Clean Cars for All (CCFA) program will close to new applicants on January 31, 2024. The Air District will reopen the program by March 1, 2024 and expand the program to the entire Bay Area. The program will also have programmatic changes that affect income eligibility, retired vehicle model year cap, and award amounts.

SUBJECT: CLEAN CARS FOR ALL PROGRAM CLOSURE AND RELAUNCH

The CCFA program will close to new applicants at **4 PM on January 31**, **2024**. The program is scheduled to reopen by **March 1**, **2024** and will include programmatic changes. Changes include, but are not limited to the following:

- **Zip codes:** expanding eligibility to all 304 Bay Area zip codes within the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's (BAAQMD) jurisdiction.
- **Income**: reducing the eligible household income limit to 300% of the federal poverty level, or FPL (previously 400% of the FPL).
- Retired vehicle: increasing the vehicle model year cap to 2007 or older (previously 2005).
- **Award:** increasing award amounts to a range between \$7,000 and \$12,000 (previously \$5,000 to \$9,500), which includes an additional \$2,000 for participants who live in <u>disadvantaged community census tracts</u> and purchase a plug-in electric or fuel cell electric vehicle.

Participants who have submitted applications before the program relaunch must submit a new application and qualify for any increased award amounts. Eligibility will be subject to current program requirements at the time of application submission. Participants that have already purchased or leased a vehicle through CCFA, are not eligible for increased award amounts. Applications submitted prior to the closure will continue to be reviewed and active Award Letters may still to be used.

^{**} Conventional hybrids will be removed as an eligible vehicle by November 1, 2024, and no conventional hybrids will be allowed to be purchased after December 31, 2024
