



# CLEAN CARS FOR ALL

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Income-eligible Bay Area residents can **receive up to \$12,000 to trade in their old vehicle** and **purchase or lease an electric vehicle**, or get a **prepaid card** for **public transit** or an **e-bike!**

## PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

**Eligibility is based on income, residency within the Air District, and eligible vehicle to retire!**

1. You are a new applicant to a vehicle replacement grant program
2. You are a Bay Area resident (within the Air District's jurisdiction)\*
3. You have a qualifying household income
4. Your vehicle to retire is a model year 2007 or older passenger vehicle, operated in California for the last 2 years, and under 10,000 pounds

**To qualify for Clean Cars for All,** you must have an annual household income below our income cap. These caps are shown in the table at the right.

# APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete an application to verify your eligibility at [BAAQMD.gov/CleanCarsforAll](http://BAAQMD.gov/CleanCarsforAll)
2. Bring your old vehicle, model year 2007 or older, to an authorized dismantler to verify vehicle requirements.
3. If eligibility requirements are met and you are awarded a grant, you will receive an award letter from the Air District.
4. Buy or lease a new or used qualifying electric vehicle from an authorized dealership or receive your prepaid card for public transit or an e-bike.
5. Take your old vehicle to an approved dismantler for scrapping.

<sup>1</sup> Participants purchasing a vehicle may be eligible for up to \$5,000 toward the cost of vehicle adaptive equipment.

<sup>2</sup> Up to \$2,000 may be available for an EV charger rebate, portable charger or public charge card.

<sup>3</sup> Participants who reside in a Disadvantaged Community (DAC) census tract may be eligible to receive an additional \$2,000 in grant funding. To determine if you live in a DAC, please visit the link below.
