Virtual Workshop on CEMEX, Hanson Aggregates and other Bayview Hunters Point Facilities

Come learn about how the Air District is
regulating these facilities and provide public comment

Dear Bay Area Community,

The Air District is conducting a virtual public workshop to present, discuss, and receive comments on Cemex Construction Materials Pacific, LLC, Hanson Aggregates Mid-Pacific, Inc and other Bayview Hunters Point facilities located along Amador Street in Eastern San Francisco. At the workshop, Air District staff will provide presentations on the air quality impacts from the facilities and respond to questions on the relevant draft permits and community concerns.

When:

The workshop will be held using Zoom and will take place on **Thursday, June 3, 2021, from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.**

Why:

The Air District regulates emissions from stationary source facilities throughout the Bay Area. In the Bayview neighborhood of San Francisco along Amador St., there are several operational stationary

sources subject to air quality regulations and rules aimed toward reducing air pollution and protecting public health. These facilities include CEMEX, Hanson Aggregates, Central Concrete, Recology and Darling Ingredients

CEMEX and Hanson Aggregates currently have active applications for air quality permits from the Air District. The applications are:

- Application #28001, Plant #17111 CEMEX Construction Materials
- Application #28839, Plant #13407 Hanson Aggregates
- Application #27982, Plant #23564 Hanson Aggregates

These applications evaluate emissions of criteria pollutants and toxic air contaminants and determine compliance with Air District regulations.

We invite you to a community workshop to discuss the facilities, ask questions and hear from Air District leadership and staff about permit requirements, emissions modeling and enforcement of air quality regulations and rules.
